'*Cash Not Care: the planned demolition of the UK welfare state*' was self-published by Mo Stewart in September 2016 via New Generation Publishing.

Following six years of self-funded independent research the creation of '*Cash Not Care*' took another year, with an enormous battle trying to find a publisher willing to publish the research findings. Demonstrating the power of corporate America, none of the usual publishers were willing 'to risk' exposing the influence of corporate America with the reforms of the British welfare state and so '*Cash Not Care*' was eventually self-published and was released in September 2016, costing thousands of pounds that this author didn't have. Debt was inevitable. Written for and on behalf of the sick and disabled community, who historically don't have a voice '*Cash Not Care*' has received several book reviews:
